



#### Day 1: Madrid (Arrival Day)

Arrive in Madrid from the US and check into your hotel, located in the heart of the city. Take a relaxing evening walk around Puerta del Sol, one of Madrid's most famous squares, where the Kilometer Zero plaque marks the geographical center of Spain. Continue to Plaza Mayor, a historic square surrounded by elegant porticoes and bustling cafes. Dinner at the hotel.






#### Day 2: Madrid

Begin the day with a guided tour of the Royal Palace, the largest functioning royal palace in Western Europe, featuring opulent rooms and stunning gardens. Next, visit the Almudena Cathedral, a modern cathedral blending Gothic, Romanesque, and Neoclassical styles. Continue to the Prado Museum, home to masterpieces by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco. Conclude the afternoon with a peaceful walk through Retiro Park, where you can admire the Crystal Palace and the serene lake. Dinner at the hotel.




## Day 3: Madrid > Toledo > Cordoba

Depart in the morning for Toledo, a UNESCO World
Heritage city known for its rich cultural heritage. Visit the
Toledo Cathedral, a stunning Gothic masterpiece with
impressive altarpieces and stained glass windows.
Wander through the Jewish Quarter, with its narrow
medieval streets and artisan shops. After free time for
lunch, continue to Cordoba. Upon arrival, explore the
Mezquita-Catedral, a striking mosque-cathedral
blending Moorish and Christian architecture, and stroll
through the picturesque Jewish Quarter, known for its
flower-filled patios. Dinner at the hotel.







## Day 4: Cordoba > Granada

Depart for Granada. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and take a guided tour of the Alhambra Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage site showcasing exquisite Moorish architecture, including the Nasrid Palaces, Generalife Gardens, and the Alcazaba Fortress. Dinner at the hotel.







#### Day 5: Granada > Ronda > Sevilla

Depart for Ronda in the morning. beautiful white town with its large gap that cuts the city in half. Continuation to SEVILLE. Dinner at the hotel.





#### Day 6: Sevilla

After breakfast walk through Barrio Santa Cruz, the city's charming old Jewish Quarter. Visit the Sevilla Cathedral, one of the largest Gothic cathedrals in the world, and climb the La Giralda tower for panoramic views of the city. Continue with a tour of the Alcázar of Seville, a breathtaking palace with intricate Moorish architecture and lush gardens. We Will have our dinner at a local Restaurant with flamenco show.







#### Day 7: Sevilla – Evora > Lisbon

Travel to Lisbon, en route we will stop at Evora, famous town on the World Unesco's World Hertitage list, then we'll continue to Portugal's vibrant capital. Check into your hotel and stroll through the Baixa and Chiado districts, home to elegant squares, lively cafes, and historic shops. Stop to taste a warm pastel de nata at a local bakery. Free afternoon in the ciy center. Transfer to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel.





## Day 8: Lisbon & Fátima Day Trip + Lisbon Highlights

Take a morning excursion to Fátima, one of the most important pilgrimage sites in the world. Visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Fátima, including the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary and the Chapel of the Apparitions, where the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared in 1917. Return to Lisbon and explore Belém Tower, the Jerónimos Monastery, and the Monument to the Discoveries, all symbols of Portugal's Age of Exploration. In the evening, enjoy dinner with live Fado music in Bairro Alto.







#### Day 9: Lisbon > Porto

Journey to Porto, the city of bridges and port wine. Wander through the colorful Ribeira district along the Douro River, with its lively cafes and charming alleyways. In the evening, tour a Port wine cellar and learn about the production of this famous local wine, followed by a tasting session. Dinner at the hotel.





#### Day 10: Porto

Explore Livraria Lello, one of the most beautiful bookstores in the world, then climb the Clérigos Tower for panoramic views of the city. Stop outside the Palácio da Bolsa, a historic stock exchange with magnificent interiors. Walk across the Dom Luís I Bridge, designed by a disciple of Gustave Eiffel, and enjoy stunning views of the city skyline. Spend the afternoon shopping or relaxing by the river. Dinner at the hotel.







#### Day 11: Porto > Madrid

Return to Madrid by bus. Spend your final afternoon shopping along Gran Vía or visiting the Temple of Debod, an ancient Egyptian temple in the heart of the city. Conclude your journey with a farewell dinner featuring traditional paella or tapas.





#### Day 12: Departure from Madrid

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the US.
