MELBOURNE – CAIRNS – SYDNEY - CHRISTCHURCH - QUEENSTOWN – AUCKLAND- ROTORUA

DAY 1: - ARRIVAL DAY MELBOURNE

Pick up from Airport, check in at hotel (early check in optional) Melbourne is known for being one of the most livable cities on earth. Often referred to as the sporting capital of the world, besides this , also famous for its graphitized laneways. Check in hotel Dinner

DAY 2: - City and Philips Island

After breakfast proceed for a **Melbourne city tour** Drive to **Moonlit Wildlife Park** – hand feed friendly kangaroos (optional) Proceed to **Philips Island** to watch Penguin Parade, where little penguins come from the sea to the shore by sunset, to their nests. Sydney orientation tour (St Mary's Cathedral, Harbor bridge)

It had 558 residents according to the 2018 census, being one of five settlements in the sparsely populated Mackenzie Basin. Lake Tekapo is known for its beautiful water colour as well as its proximity and access to the Southern Alps. The town is close to Mount Cook National Park and home to lots of great attractions including one of New Zealand's only Dark Sky Reserves.

Later transfer to **Lake pukai**. you can see the Aoraki / Mount Cook is the highest mountain in New Zealand. Its height, as of 2014, is listed as 3,724 metres

Proceed to **Queenstown**, Queenstown, New Zealand, sits on the shores of the South Island's Lake Wakatipu, set against the dramatic Southern Alps. Renowned for adventure sports, it's also a base for exploring the region's vineyards and historic mining towns.
